# Present Tense

## ■ There are 4 types of Present Tense-

- 1. Present Indefinite
- 2. Present Continuous
- 3. Present Perfect
- 4. Present Perfect Continuous

## Present Indefinite Tense

**पहचान-** Present indefinite tense में हिन्दी वाक्यों के अन्त में ता है, ती है, ते हैं, ता हूँ, ती हूँ, ते हो आदि आता है ।

Example -. 1. राधा एक मधुर गीत गाती है ।

2. वे खेत जोतते हैं ।

■ 3. हम रोज़ाना रात को फिल्म देखते हैं ।

## Affirmative Sentence

- **Present Indefinite Tense** बनाने के लिए निम्नलिखित नियमों का पालन किया जाता है -
- Affirmative Sentence के लिए
- (a) Subject (he,she,it and other singular) + 1st form of Verb + s/es+ Object
- (b) Sub(I,we, you,they and other plural)+ 1st form of verb+ object

Example-

- 1. वह स्कूल जाता है ।  
He goes to school.
- 2. शीला खाना बनाती है ।  
Sheela cooks the food.
- 3. हम गाना गाते हैं ।  
We sing a song.
- 4. वे क्रिकेट खेलते हैं ।  
They play cricket.

Negative  
Sentence के  
लिए

- (a) Subject(he,she,it and other singular)+ does not + 1st form of Verb + Object
- (b) Sub(I,we, you,they and other plural) + do not + 1st form of Verb + object

## Example-

- 1. सोनम भोजन नहीं पकाती है ।  
Sonam does not cook the food.
- 2. हम क्रिकेट नहीं खेलते हैं ।  
we do not play cricket.
- 3. वे पुस्तक नहीं पढ़ते हैं ।  
They do not read book.



# Interrogative Sentence

- (a) Does + Subject (he,she,it and other singular) + 1st form of Verb + Object

- Or

Question word + does + Subject (he,she,it and other singular) + 1st form of Verb + Object

(b ) Do + Sub(I,we, you,they and other plural)+ 1st form of verb+ object

or Question word+ do + Sub(I,we, you,they and other plural)+ 1st form of verb+ object

Example-

- 1. क्या तुम गिटार बजाते हो ?
- Do you play the guitar ?
- 2. वह काम क्यों करता है ?
- Why does he work ?
- 3. तुम कहाँ रहते हो ?
- Where do you live ?
- 4. क्या वह हर रोज मंदिर जाती है ? Does she go to the temple daily ?
